Dear Parents & Guardians,  
Congratulations!! Your child has auditioned for and received a part in our Kenwal Players' production of "*Peter Pan*," taking place on **WEDNESDAY, August 21<sup>st</sup>**.

**Differing from years past, the show will be presented at  
NORTH SHORE SYNAGOGUE, 83 Muttontown Eastwoods Rd, Syosset, NY 11791.  
Because of their tight security, doors will open to everyone at 6:30pm.  
YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO COME EARLY AND SAVE SEATS.**

While you await our performance, there will be a dinner buffet provided, starting at 7:00pm.

**VERY IMPORTANT:**

There will be two *full dress* rehearsals at camp, **Wednesday** morning and afternoon, for our fellow campers to see. **All ensemble cast members should bring their costume to camp WEDNESDAY morning, in a bag with their name on it. They SHOULD NOT wear their costumes to camp.** They will then bring them home at the end of the day and **should wear them to NORTH SHORE SYNAGOGUE** for the evening performance.

**COSTUMES**

\*\*All main characters will be spoken with separately regarding their costumes.\*\*

**\*Please note: no one should be wearing flip flops or sandals, there should NOT be any words, name brands, sports teams, etc. on any costumes and everyone's costumes should be as whimsical, fairy tale and storybook looking as possible.\***

"I Won't Grow Up" Lost Boys and Lost Girls AND "Ugg-a-Wugg" Lost Girls: The Lost Boys and Girls live with Peter Pan in the forest of Neverland and their clothing resembles the things around them, like animals and nature. Be as creative as you can and be sure to include animal prints or faux fur or lots of green/tan/brown so it looks as though they made their clothing from plants and nature. Or cut the hem of your clothes into points for a ragged/tattered look! GIRLS can wear a top with a skirt or pants OR a dress with dance shoes, jazz shoes or ballet flats. A tan or neutral colored sandal with a back is ok as a last resort, but we prefer close toed shoes. Hairstyles can be fun and wild since they live in the forest and don't have hairbrushes! BOYS can wear a shirt with pants or shorts and sneakers or sandals with a back (no flip flops). Hair can be wild and crazy!

Don't forget accessories! Finish your look with a sash, belt, vest, hat, bandana, high socks, etc. Be sure to add smudges and scratches on your face or arms to show you live in the forest! Brown or black eyeshadow works well!

"Ugg-a-Wugg" Brave Girls: Our Brave Girls' costumes shirts will be provided for them. They will need to bring in a pair of leggings or shorts in solid black or brown. They should wear jazz shoes, dance shoes or ballet flats. Hair can be a pony tail or braided pig tails. Be sure to bring face makeup to create a Native American tribal look. This can be added when they change into their Brave Girl costumes.

"Captain Hook's Waltz" Pirates: Our Pirate ensemble can sing with their captain and tells him how wonderfully evil he is! GIRLS can wear a pirate Halloween costume or a top and pants/shorts/skirt with dance shoes, jazz shoes or ballet flats. Please stay within the red, black and white color scheme and be as creative as you want! BOYS may wear a pirate Halloween costume or a shirt and pants within our red, black and white color scheme. Hair for boys and girls can be messy and wild or you can wear a hat.

ALL PIRATE BOYS and GIRLS: be sure to add face makeup -scars, eyeliner, mustaches, etc. and **WEARABLE ACCESSORIES** – eye patches, scarves, pirate hats, etc. Please **NO PROPS OR ITEMS THEY HAVE TO HOLD**; they need their hands free to dance. **PLEASE NO SWORDS OR WEAPONS!**

**MAKE-UP**

Before bringing your child to the North Shore Synagogue, we recommend that you help them apply some basic stage makeup, which would include **light eyeliner and skin-tone foundation**. This will keep their faces from being washed out by the lights on stage. All other character makeup descriptions are above.

**ALL OTHER PRINCIPALS: 6:45 pm.** (Named characters, soloists, etc.)

**ALL OTHERS: 7:00 pm.** (Ensemble including “I Won’t Grow Up,” “Ugg-a-Wugg”, “Captain Hook’s Waltz”, etc.)

Our performance is scheduled to begin at **8:00 PM.**

**PLEASE HAVE YOUR CAST MEMBER ARRIVE ON TIME FOR PROPER PREPARATION.**

Once again, our production will be held at **NORTH SHORE SYNAGOGUE, 83 Muttontown Eastwoods Rd, Syosset, NY 11791** on **WEDNESDAY, August 21<sup>st</sup>.**
